- What is qualified as torture and inhumane treatment (according to the ECHR practice)
- The reasons why torture and inhumane treatment has become a systemic problem
- Current situation in penitentiary establishments
- Rehabilitation of victims of torture and corresponding state strategy
- Whether acts of torture are investigated effectively
- Public approach towards torture and inhumane treatment, and whether raising public awareness is necessary
- And lastly, prevention of torture and inhumane treatment.

The Public Defender of Georgia, representatives of the Ministry of Corrections and Legal Assistance, the office of the prosecutor, NGOs, media, students and other stakeholders contributed to the discussions.
