On September 30, 2012, Georgian Young Lawyers' Association held a pre-conference about GYLA's monitoring mission for October 1, 2012 parliamentary elections.

GYLA will monitor the parliamentary elections day in Tbilisi and 35 districts throughout 9 regions of Georgia.

Static observers have been placed in 195 election precincts throughout Georgia. Mobile groups will be moving throughout 35 districts. GYLA will monitor precincts set up in exceptional cases, precincts in districts mostly settled by minorities and precincts that proved to be problematic during previous regions.
